AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARAMOUNT ADDING ARTICLE XI TO CHAPTER 29 OF THE PARAMOUNT MUNICIPAL CODE ESTABLISHING THE FORFEITURE OF NUISANCE VEHICLES ENGAGED MOTOR VEHICLE SPEED CONTESTS OR EXHIBITIONS OF SPEED.

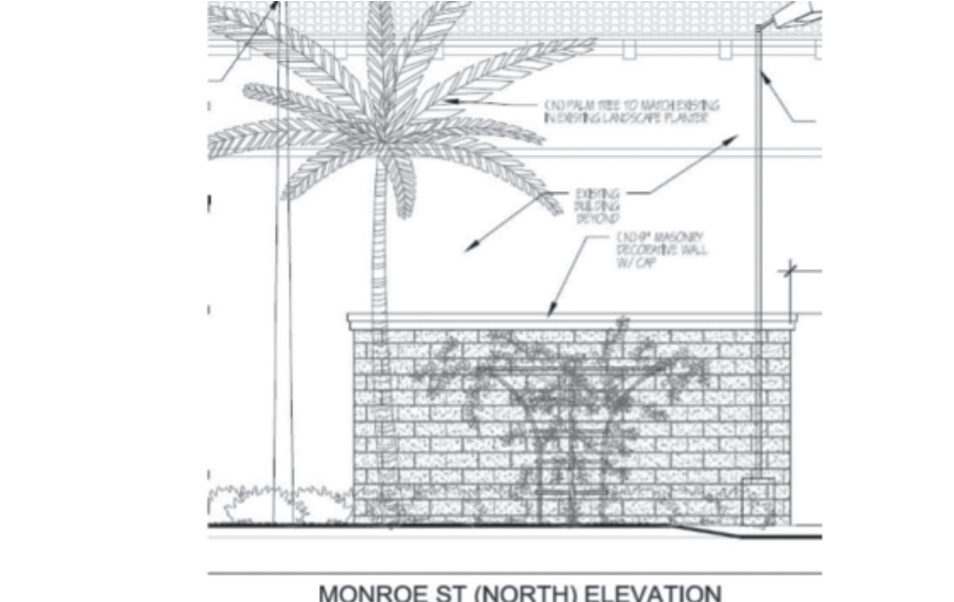
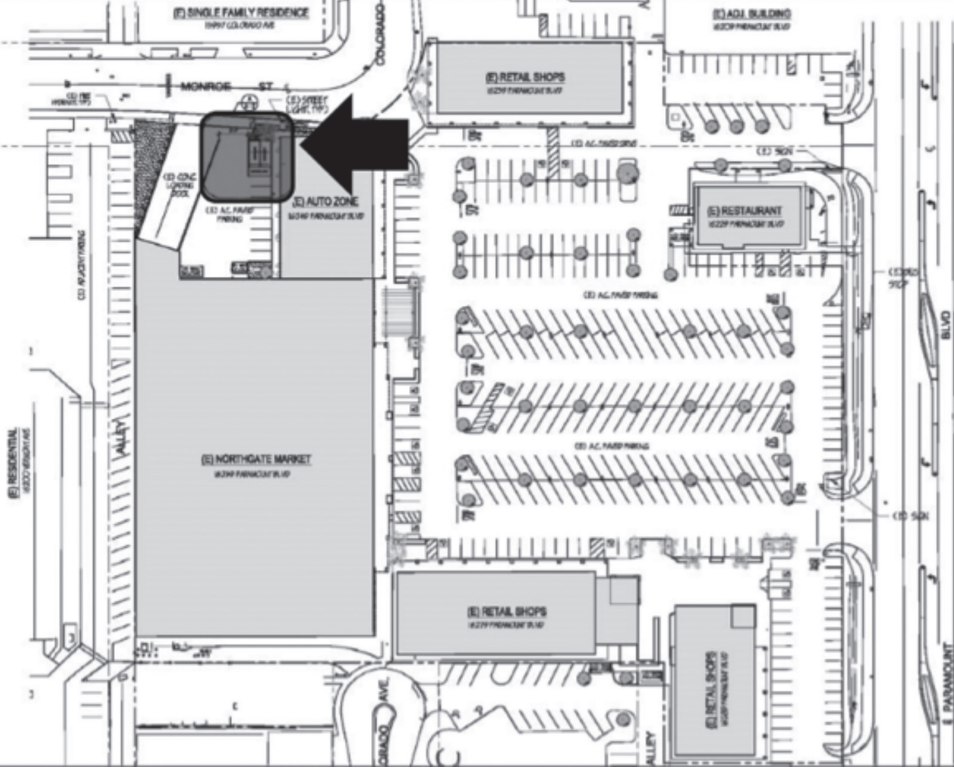
