sonal representative, as defined in section 58(b) of the California Probate Code, or (2) 60 days from the date of mailing or personal delivery to you of a notice under section 9052 of the California Probate Code. Other California statutes and legal authority may affect your rights as a creditor. You may want to consult with an attorney knowledgeable in Cali-

fornia law. YOU MAY EXAMINE the file kept by the court. **NOTICE OF PROPOSED WATER RATE ADJUSTMENT**

Notice is hereby given that the Paramount City Council will conduct a hearing to consider a proposed water rate adjustment. The public hearing will be held at the regular meeting of the City Council beginning at or near 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 2, 2021, in the Council Chambers, City Hall, 16400 Colorado Avenue, Paramount, California.

Article XII(D) of the California Constitution under Proposition 218 requires the City of Paramount to mail public notices 45 days in advance of a public hearing to water rate payers regarding a proposed water rate adjustment whereby water rate payers may submit written protests. The City mailed the public notices to Paramount water customers on September 11, 2021. Under Proposition 218, Paramount water customers may submit a written protest before the Public Hearing protests can be sent by 1st-class mail, postage prepaid, to City of Paramount City Hall (Attn: City Clerk) at 16400 Colorado Avenue, Paramount, California 90723. Mailed protests must be received by the City Clerk no later than the close of the Public Hearing. Written protests must indicate the property address and the name of the property owner or customer of record, and written protests must be signed by that person. Any protests received after the close of the Public Hearing will not be counted. The City Council welcomes all public input and will consider it as part of the decision-making process. However, to count as a legal protest, an objection must be in writing, be signed by the customer of record, and identify the property. Only one water rate protest will be counted per parcel.

Comments will be limited to those issues raised at the Public Hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence to the City of Paramount at, or prior to, the Public Hearing.

If you challenge the Resolution in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Paramount at, or prior to, the public hearing.
