



ORDINANCE NO. 1161

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARAMOUNT, CALIFORNIA AMENDING THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION OF THE CALI-FORNIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND THE CITY OF PARAMOUNT TO TERMINATE THE POLICE MEMBER RETIRE-MENT GROUP PLAN WHEREAS, the Public Employees' Retirement Law permits the participation of public agencies and their employees in the Public Employees'

Retirement System by the execution of a contract, and sets forth the procedure by which said public agencies may elect to subject themselves and their employees to amendments to said Law; WHEREAS, one of the steps in the procedures to amend this contract is the adoption by the governing body of the public agency of a resolution giving notice of its intention to approve an amendment to said contract, which resolution

shall contain a summary of the change proposed

WHEREAS, the following is a statement of the proposed change: "To provide for termination of the police member group and transfer of accumulated contributions to the terminated agency pool the accumulated contributions shall be held in the terminated agency pool for the exclusive benefit of each member of the police member group in relation to the credited service of each police member. The local police member classification of the Public Agency no longer has active employees as of the effective date of this amend-

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARAMOUNT DOES ORDAIN AS
