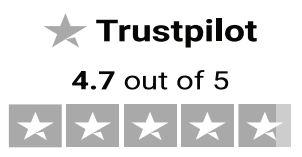

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARAMOUNT AMENDING SECTIONS 12.24.030, 12.24.050, 12.24.070, 12.42.080, 12.42.090, 12.42.140, AND 12.42.160 OF THE PARAMOUNT MUNICIPAL CODE, REVISING REGULATIONS FOR MOBILE FOOD VENDORS TO FURTHER EXTEND MOBILE VENDING HOURS AND UPDATE MOBILE FOOD VENDOR PERMITTING AND OPERATION REQUIREMENTS IN THE CITY OF PARAMOUNT

On February 11, 2025, the Paramount City Council voted to introduce Ordinance No. 1196 amending the Paramount Municipal Code to revise the regulations for mobile food vendors to further extend mobile vending hours and update mobile food vendor permitting and operation requirements in the City of Paramount.
