AMENDMENT

A commercial business is applying to introduce
commercial delivery of small merchandise as a
possibility with an approved conditional use per-
mit. If the City approves the proposed Zoning Or-
dinance Text Amendment, which would only ap-
ply to businesses and properties in Paramount's
C-3 (General Commercial) zone, an interested
commercial business would then be required to
apply for a conditional use permit (CUP). This
CUP application would require a public hearing
that would be subject to public notification re-
quirements, including direct mail to all property
owners and tenants within 500 feet, newspaper
publication, and notification on the City website.

Below is a summary of the details:

REQUEST: Notice of Zoning Ordinance Text
Amendment No. 43; a recommendation for the
City Council of the City of Paramount to adopt an
ordinance including commercial drone delivery as
a use permitted subject to conditional use permit
in the C-3 (General Commercial) zone following
public notification and a public hearing.

LOCATION: Citywide in the C-3 (General Com-
mercial) zone

ENVIRONMENTAL STATUS: This project is ex-
empt from California Environmental Quality Act
(CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section
15061(b)(3) which is the general rule that CEQA
applies only to projects which have the potential
for causing a significant effect on the environ-
ment. CEQA does not apply to projects where it
can be seen with certainty that there is no possi-
bility that the activity may have a significant effect
on the environment.

ALL INTERESTED PERSONS are invited to par-
ticipate in said Public Hearing to express their
opinion about this matter. Comments may be
provided orally, in writing, including by email to
planning@paramountcity.gov. Written comments
other than email must be received at or by the
time of the hearing on Wednesday, September 2,
2026. Email public comments must be received
15 minutes prior to the start of the meeting to
confirm the emailed comments are received for
the item.

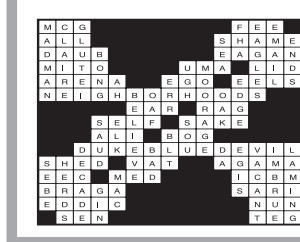

mount at, or prior to, the public hearing.

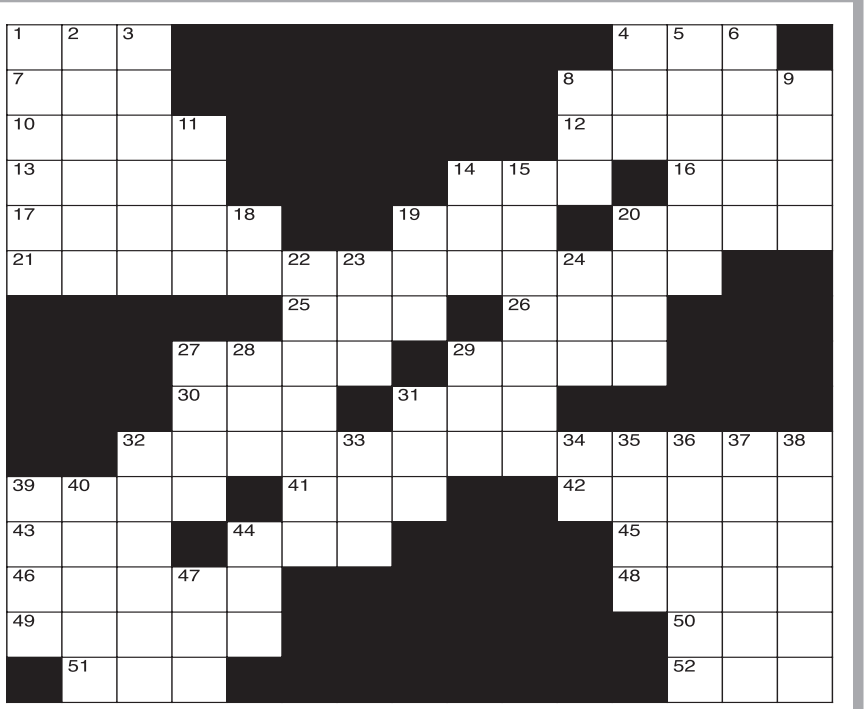
